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Short Title: Orange County Local Disclosure Act Repeal. (Local) Sponsors: Senator Kinnaird. Referred to: State and Local Government. February 21, 2011 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REPEAL A LOCAL ACT CONCERNING FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE BY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY SINCE A GENERAL LAW NOW PROVIDES FOR AN ETHICS POLICY. Whereas, pursuant to the mandate of G.S. 160A-86 requiring local governing boards adopt a Code of Ethics by December 31, 2010, the Orange County Board of Commissioners adopted a Code of Ethics on June 1, 2010; and Whereas, included in the adopted Code of Ethics are disclosure requirements for the Orange County Commissioners substantially similar to those mandated by Chapter 460 of the 1987 Session Laws; and Whereas, it is unduly burdensome to Orange County to be the sole county subject to disclosure requirements both pursuant to a local act and general law; Now, therefore, The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Title VII of Chapter 460 of the 1987 Session Laws, being Sections
