BILL SUMMARY:

House Bill 1203 amends SL 1991-80 to allow Martin County to retain 6% (was 3%) of the first \$500,000 of gross proceeds collected each year from the Martin County Occupancy Tax to be retained by the county for administrative costs.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

The bill would increase the amount of Martin County Occupancy Tax collections that can be retained by the county for administrative costs from 3% of the first \$500,000 of gross proceeds to 6% of the first \$500,000 of gross proceeds. The bill would have no impact of Martin County Occupancy Tax revenue.
