#### **BILL SUMMARY**:

Senate Bill 918 amends Section 9 of SL 2001-480, as amended, to add that the Durham Convention and Visitors Bureau may use occupancy tax proceeds to cover tourism-related expenses and to retire debt incurred to finance such expenses.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:**

Senate Bill 918 redefines what items the Durham Convention and Visitors Bureau may use excess occupancy tax proceeds to cover. There is no fiscal impact associated with this change.
