The Division is authorized to collect a fee not to exceed three dollars (\$3.00) for each conversion." **EXCLUDE FEDERAL LANDS ACCESS FUNDS SECTION 2.** G.S. 136-189.11(b) reads as rewritten: "(b) Funds Excluded From Formula. - The following funds are not subject to this section: (1) Federal congestion mitigation and air quality improvement program funds appropriated to the State by the United States pursuant to 23 U.S.C. § 104(b)(2) and 23 U.S.C. § 149. Funds received through competitive awards or discretionary grants through (2) federal appropriations either for local governments, transportation authorities, transit authorities, or the Department. Funds received from the federal government that under federal law may only (3)
