| 7  | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  |
| 8  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 136-189.11 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:                  |
| 9  | (c1) Emergency Funds With Alternative Criteria. — The following funds, obligated in               |
| 10 | support of emergency repair work necessary to restore essential travel, minimize the extent of    |
| 11 | damage, or protect remaining facilities, as a result of events that occurred during a federal- or |
| 12 | State-declared emergency that significantly damaged the State-maintained transportation           |
| 13 | system to the extent that safe passage is jeopardized, shall be subject to subsection (d) of this |
| 14 | section but shall not be subject to the prioritization criteria set forth in that subsection:     |
| 15 | (1) Federal or State funds obligated for repairs for which federal Emergency                      |
| 16 | Relief Funds are available pursuant to 23 U.S.C. § 125.   |
| 17 | (2) State funds obligated for repairs to damage occurring as a result of an event                 |
| 18 | that is lawfully declared to be a federal or State emergency."                                    |
| 19 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.                                      |
