Numbers of judges by districts; numbers of magistrates and additional seats 8 of court, by counties. 9 Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the (a) 10 following table: 11 District Judges County 12 13 14 12 10 <u>12</u> Cumberland 15 16 Each county shall have the numbers of magistrates and additional seats of district 17 court, as set forth in the following table: 18 Additional 19 Seats of Magistrates 20 Min. Court County 21 22 Cumberland 19 <u>21</u> 23"

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of three hundred eighteen thousand seven hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$318,788) for the 2013-2014 fiscal year and the sum of three hundred eighteen thousand seven hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$318,788) for the 2014-2015 fiscal year to establish two additional district court judge positions for District Court District 12.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of ninety thousand nine hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$90,939) for the 2013-2014 fiscal year and the sum of ninety thousand nine hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$90,939) for the 2014-2015 fiscal year to establish two additional magistrate positions for Cumberland County.

SECTION 4. The Governor shall appoint the two additional district court judges for District Court District 12 authorized by this act, and those judges' successors shall be elected in the 2014 election for four-year terms commencing January 1, 2015.

SECTION 5. This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
