A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR MISUSE OF THE 911 3 SYSTEM.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 14-111.4 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 14-111.4. Misuse of 911 system.

7 It is unlawful for an individual who is not seeking public safety assistance, is not providing 8 911 service, or is not responding to a 911 call to access or attempt to access the 911 system for a purpose other than an emergency communication. A person who knowingly violates this 9 section commits a Class 3 misdemeanor. If a person knowingly accesses or attempts to access 10 the 911 system for the purpose of avoiding a charge for voice communications service, as 11 defined in G.S. 62A-40, and the value of the charge exceeds one hundred dollars (\$100.00), the 12 13 person commits a Class 1 misdemeanor." SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2013, and applies to 14

15 offenses committed on or after that date.
