5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 105-277.2(2) reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 105-277.2. Agricultural, horticultural, and forestland – Definitions.
8	The following definitions apply in G.S. 105-277.3 through G.S. 105-277.7:
9	
10	(2) Forestland. – Land that is a part of a forest unit that is actively engaged in
11	the commercial growing of trees under a sound management program.trees.
12	Forestland includes wasteland that is a part of the forest unit, but the
13	wasteland included in the unit must be appraised under the use-value
14	schedules as wasteland. A forest unit may consist of more than one tract of
15	forestland, but at least one of the tracts must meet the requirements in
16	G.S. 105-277.3(a)(3), and each tract must be under a sound management
17	program. <u>G.S. 105-277.3(a)(3).</u>

19	SECTION 2. G.S. 105-277.3(g) is repealed.
20	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2013.
