Short Title: Inspection Requirements for Salvaged Vehicles. (Public) Committee on Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House. Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR USED VEHICLES SOLD ON A SALVAGE TITLE BY DEALERS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-183.4C(a) reads as rewritten: "\second 20-183.4C. When a vehicle must be inspected; 10-day trip permit. Inspection. – A vehicle that is subject to a safety inspection, an emissions inspection, or both must be inspected as follows: (2) A used vehicle must be inspected before it is offered for sale at retail in this State by a dealer. Upon purchase, a receipt approved by the Division must be provided to the new owner certifying compliance. However, a used vehicle sold on a salvage title, where no repairs have been made to the vehicle after issuance of the salvage title, may be sold without inspection by a dealer.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
