A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR USED VEHICLES SOLD ON A SALVAGE TITLE BY DEALERS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 20-183.4C(a) reads as rewritten: "§ 20-183.4C. When a vehicle must be inspected; 10-day trip permit. (a) Inspection. — A vehicle that is subject to a safety inspection, an emissions inspection, or both must be inspected as follows:		
 (2 S :	A used vehicle must be inspected before it is offered for sale at retail in State by a dealer. Upon purchase, a receipt approved by the Division must provided to the new owner certifying compliance. However, a used vesold on a salvage title, where no repairs have been made to the vehicle issuance of the salvage title, may be sold without inspection by a dealer. "ECTION 2.
