SENATE BILL 107

2 AN ACT ALLOWING PERSONS PRACTICING AS CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL
3 MIDWIVES IN THIS STATE TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE MIDWIFERY SERVICES
4 WITHOUT BEING SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL PENALTY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
7 Article to read:

8 "Article 10B.

9 "Practice of Midwifery by Certified Professional Midwives.

10 "**§ 90-178.10. Practice of midwifery by certified professional midwife.**

11 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any person who holds a current
12 ministerial or tocological certification from an organization accredited by the Institute for
13 Credentialing Excellence (ICE) may provide services as described in 42 U.S.C. §
14 1396r-6(b)(4)(E)(ii)(I)."

15 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
