

2	AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO THE STATE BUDGET ACT.
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 143C-1-1(d)(19) reads as rewritten:
5	"(19) Nontax revenue. – Revenue that is not a tax proceed or a departmental
6	receipt and that is required by statute to be credited to the General Fund.a
7	fund."
8	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 143C-1-1(d)(30) reads as rewritten:
9	"(30) Unreserved fund balance The available General Fund cash balance
10	effective June 30 after excluding documented encumbrances, unearned
11	revenue, federal grants, statutory requirements, and other legal obligations to
12	General Fund a fund's cash balance as determined by the State Controller.
13	Beginning unreserved fund balance equals ending unreserved fund balance
14	from the prior fiscal year."
15	<b>SECTION 3.</b> G.S. 143C-1-3(c) reads as rewritten:
16	"(c) Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) of this section, funds established for The
17	University of North Carolina and its constituent institutions pursuant to the following statutes
18	are exempt from Chapter 143C of the General Statutes and shall be accounted for as provided
19	by those statutes, except that the provisions of Article 8 of Chapter 143C of the General
20	Statutes shall apply to the funds: G.S. 116-35, 116-36, 116-36.1, 116-36.2, 116-36.4, 116-36.5,
21	116-36.6, 116-44.4, 116-68, 116-220, <del>116-235, 116-238.<u>116-235.</u>"</del>
22	SECTION 4. G.S. 143C-3-5(e) reads as rewritten:
23	"(e) <u>Revenue</u> <u>Availability</u> Estimates. – The recommended Current Operations
24	Appropriations Act shall contain a statement showing the estimates of General Fund
25	availability, Highway Fund availability, and Highway Trust Fund availability upon which the
26	Recommended State Budget is based."
27	SECTION 5. G.S. 143C-9-6 reads as rewritten:
28	"§ 143C-9-6. JDIG Reserve Fund. Reserve.
29	(a) The State Controller shall establish a reserve in the General Fund to be known as the
30	JDIG Reserve. Funds from the JDIG Reserve shall not be expended or transferred except in
31	accordance with G.S. 143B-437.63.
32	(b) It is the intent of the General Assembly to appropriate funds annually to the JDIG
33 34	Reserve established in this section in amounts sufficient to meet the anticipated cash
34 35	requirements for each fiscal year of the Job Development Investment Grant Program established pursuant to G.S. 143B-437.52."
35 36	SECTION 6. G.S. 143C-9-8(a) reads as rewritten:
