The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> Part 3 of Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended		
by adding a new section to read:		
"§ 116-40.12. Student organizations; rights and recognition.		
<u>(a)</u> <u>Te</u>	o the extent allowed by State and federal law, a student organization	<u>ı may</u>
determine that ordering the organization's internal affairs, selecting the organization's leaders,		
defining the organization's doctrines, and resolving the organization's disputes are in		
furtherance of the organization's mission and that only persons committed to that mission		
should conduct such activities.		
	lo constituent institution that has granted recognition of and access to any s	
organization or group shall discriminate against any such student organization or group that		
exercises its rights pursuant to subsection (a) of this section."		

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
