

5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7	PART I. INTRODUCTION AND TITLE OF ACT

9	INTRODUCTION
10	SECTION 1.1. The appropriations made in this act are for maximum amounts
11	necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the budget in
12	accordance with the State Budget Act. Savings shall be affected where the total amounts
13	appropriated are not required to perform these services and accomplish these purposes, and the
14	savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at the end of each fiscal year, except as otherwise
15	provided by law.

17	TITLE OF ACT
18	SECTION 1.2. This act shall be known as the "Current Operations and Capital
19	Improvements Appropriations Act of 2013."

SECTION 6.1. The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the
General Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated in this act by reference.

MOST TEXT APPLIES ONLY TO THE 2013-2015 FISCAL BIENNIUM
SECTION 6.2. Except for statutory changes or other provisions that clearly
indicate an intention to have effects beyond the 2013-2015 fiscal biennium, the textual
provisions of this act apply only to funds appropriated for, and activities occurring during, the
2013-2015 fiscal biennium.
EFFECT OF HEADINGS
SECTION 6.3. The headings to the parts and sections of this act are a convenience
to the reader and are for reference only. The headings do not expand, limit, or define the text of
this act, except for effective dates referring to a Part.
SEVERABILITY CLAUSE
SECTION 6.4. If any section or provision of this act is declared unconstitutional or
invalid by the courts, it does not affect the validity of this act as a whole or any part other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid
