16		(3)	Funds received from the federal government that under federal law may only			
17			be used for Appalachian Development Highway System projects.			
18		(4)	Funds used in repayment of "GARVEE" bonds related to Phase I of the			
19			Yadkin River Veterans Memorial Bridge project.			
20		(5)	Funds committed to gap funding for toll roads funded with bonds issued			
21		>	pursuant to G.S. 136-176.			
22		(6)	Funds obligated for projects in the State Transportation Improvement
