The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-238.50A(1a) reads as rewritten:			
"(1		Cooperative innovative high school. – A high school approved by the State	
		Board of Education and the applicable governing Board that meets the	
	follov	following criteria:	
	a.	It has no more than 100 students per grade level. This criterion shall	
		not apply to a regional school as defined in G.S. 115C-238.61.	
	b.	It partners with an institution of higher education to enable students	
		to concurrently obtain a high school diploma and begin or complete	
		an associate degree program, master a certificate or vocational	
		program, or earn up to two years of college credit within five years.	
	c.	It is located on the campus of the partner institution of higher	
		education, unless the governing Board or the local board of trustees	
		for a private North Carolina college specifically waives the	
		requirement through adoption of a formal resolution. This criterion	

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the requirements of Part 9 of Article 16 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes, for the 2014-2015 school year, the Northeast Regional School of Biotechnology and Agriscience shall be designated as a cooperative innovative high school. To maintain the designation as a cooperative innovative high school beyond the 2014-2015 school year, the board of directors of the Northeast Regional School of Biotechnology and Agriscience shall apply with a local board of trustees for approval as a cooperative innovative high school program as provided under Part 9 of Article 16 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of fourteen thousand nine hundred fifteen dollars (\$14,915) for the 2014-2015 fiscal year to reimburse The University of North Carolina for tuition for courses taken by students at the Northeast Regional School of Biotechnology and Agriscience through
