13		surveyor or designer operations in a defined geographical area, and that will

16	<u>(10a)</u>	"Small water or wastewater utility owner" means any person who owns or
17		operates any underground line, system, or facility that is used for producing,
18		storing, conveying, transmitting, or distributing water under pressure or
19		sanitary sewage and that serves 100 or fewer service connections.

21	<u>(11a)</u>	"Surveyor or designer" means a person who is responsible for designing or
22		surveying underground utilities or requires a general description and location
23		of existing underground utilities in an area.

13	the following in	formation to surveyor or designer to the extent the information is reflected by
14	records in the po	ossession of and reasonably available to the utility owner:
15	<u>(1)</u>	The location and description of all of the underground utilities within the
16		area to be surveyed.
17	<u>(2)</u>	The location and description of all utility markers indicating the location of
18		the underground utilities within the area to be surveyed.
19	<u>(3)</u>	Temporary markings with paint, flags, or other visible means on the surface
20		of the ground indicating the location of the underground utilities in locations
21		where permanent utility markers do not exist.
22	<u>(4)</u>	Any other information that would assist in locating the underground
23		<u>utilities.</u> "
24		<b>TION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2013, and applies to notices given
25	on or after that d	late.
