5	SECTION 1. G.S. 143-215.107A reads as rewritten:					
6	"§ 143-215.107A. Motor vehicle emissions testing and maintenance program.					
7	(a) General Provisions. –					
8	(1) G.S. 143-215.107(a)(6) shall be implemented as provided in this section.					
9	(2) Motor vehicle emissions inspections shall be performed by a person who					
10	holds an emissions inspection mechanic license issued as provided in					
11	G.S. 20-183.4A(c) at a station that holds an emissions inspection station					
12	license issued under G.S. 20-183.4A(a) or at a place of business that holds					
13	an emissions self-inspector license issued as provided in G.S. 20-183.4A(d).					
14	Motor vehicle emissions inspections may be performed by a decentralized					
15	network of test-and-repair stations as described in 40 Code of Federal					
16	Regulations § 51.353 (1 July 1998 Edition). The Commission may not					
17	require that motor vehicle emissions inspections be performed by a network					
18	of centralized or decentralized test-only stations.
