2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT A DNA SAMPLE AND TESTING BE OBTAINED FROM
3 ANY PERSON ARRESTED FOR COMMITTING ANY FELONY OFFENSE IN THIS
4 STATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 15A-266.3A(f) reads as rewritten:

7 "(f) This section shall apply to a person arrested for ~~violating any one of the following~~
8 ~~offenses in Chapter 14 of the General Statutes:~~ committing any of the following offenses:

19 ~~emergency medical technician, medical responder, emergency department~~

23 (5) ~~Any offense in Article 10, Kidnapping and Abduction, or Article 10A,~~

25 (6) ~~G.S. 14-51, First and second degree burglary; G.S. 14-53, Breaking out of~~
26 ~~dwelling house burglary; G.S. 14-54.1, Breaking or entering a place of~~
27 ~~religious worship; and G.S. 14-57, Burglary with explosives.~~
28 (7) ~~Any offense in Article 15, Arson.~~
29 (8) ~~G.S. 14-87, Armed robbery.~~
30 (8a) Any felony offense.
31 (9) Any misdemeanor offense which would require the person to register under
32 the provisions of Article 27A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes, Sex
33 Offender and Public Protection Registration Programs.
34 (10) G.S. 14-196.3, Cyberstalking.
35 (11) G.S. 14-277.3A, Stalking.



- 1 (12) G.S. 14-43.12, Failure of party to a labor contract to report involuntary
2 servitude.
3 (13) G.S. 14-27.5A, Sexual Battery.
4 (14) G.S. 14-27.7, Intercourse and sexual offenses with certain victims (school
5 personnel less than 4 years older than the victim).
6 (15) G.S. 14-40, Enticing minors out of the State for the purpose of
7 employment."

8 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2016, and applies to offenses
9 committed on or after that date.
