A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM FROM, ON, OR ACROSS  
THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF HIGHWAY 105 OR STATE ROAD 1238 IN BURKE AND  
MCDOWELL COUNTIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it is unlawful to discharge a firearm from, on, or across the right-of-way of N.C. Highway 105 or N.C. State Road 1238.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4 of S.L. 1997-453 reads as rewritten:

"Section 4. This act applies only to McDowell ~~County, but shall not apply to those portions of the county along NC Highway 105 where there are game lands on both sides of the road.~~ County."

**SECTION 3.** Violation of Section 1 of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.

**SECTION 4.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction.

**SECTION 5.** This act applies only to Burke and McDowell Counties.

**SECTION 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
