4	SECTION 3. G.S. 20-136.2 reads as rewritten:
5	"§ 20-136.2. Air bag installation.Counterfeit and nonfunctional air bags.
6	It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to knowingly installimport,
7	manufacture, sell, offer for sale, install, or reinstall any object in lieu of an air bag, other than
8	an air bag that was designed in accordance with federal safety regulations for the make, model,
9	and year of vehicle, as part of a vehicle inflation restraint system.a counterfeit air bag or
10	nonfunctional air bag. Any person, firm, or corporation violating this section shall be guilty of a
11	Class 1-misdemeanor.H felony. In addition, a violation of this section shall constitute an unfair
12	and deceptive trade practice under G.S. 75-1.1."
13	SECTION 4. This act becomes effective December 1, 2015, and applies to
14	offenses committed on or after that date.
