6	PART III. EFFECTIVE DATES
7	SECTION 3.(a) If a majority of votes cast on the question are in favor of the
8	amendment set out in Section 1(a) of this act, the State Board of Elections shall certify the
9	amendment to the Secretary of State. The constitutional amendment shall become effective
10	upon such certification. The Secretary of State shall enroll the amendment so certified among
11	the permanent records of that office.
12	<b>SECTION 3.(b)</b> Section 2 of this act becomes effective only upon approval by the
13	voters of the constitutional amendment proposed in Section 1 of this act. If the constitutional
14	amendment proposed in Section 1 is approved by the voters, Section 2 of this act becomes
15	effective upon this certification and applies beginning with the 2016-2017 fiscal year.
16	<b>SECTION 3.(c)</b> Section 1(b) of this act is effective when this act becomes law.
