A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTERS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund or from any available 5 federal Block Grant funds to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of eight 6 hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) for the 2015-2016 fiscal year for child advocacy centers. 7 The funds shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) Seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to be allocated equally among each of the 30 fully certified child advocacy centers in this State.
- 10(2)Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to be allocated to Children's Advocacy11Centers of North Carolina, Inc., to hire a quality improvement and12development coordinator.
- 13 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2015.
