5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1.(a) G.S. 115C-84.2(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
7	read:
8	"(1b) Notwithstanding subdivision (1) of this subsection, if a school is closed due
9	to inclement weather, a natural disaster, damage to a school facility, or a
10	state of emergency, the school is required to make up a maximum of the
11	average number of days or hours made up for the last five years."
12	SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-218.85(a)(1) reads as rewritten:
13	"(1) The school shall provide instruction each year for at least 185 days or 1,025
14	hours over nine calendar months. If, however, a school is closed due to
15	inclement weather, a natural disaster, damage to a school facility, or a state
16	of emergency, the school is required to make up a maximum of the average
17	number of days or hours made up for the last five years."
18	SECTION 3. This act applies only to the Alleghany, Ashe, Avery, Caldwell, and
19	Watauga County school administrative units.
20	SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
21	the 2015-2016 school year.
