Common School Law; and

January 20, 1840; and
Whereas, there are more than 2,500 public schools in North Carolina serving diverse student population of more than 1.5 million children; and
Whereas, a strong public school system plays a critical role in fostering the
economic vitality of our great State and local communities; and
Whereas, our public schools are an integral part in ensuring our State's futur
success and prosperity; Now, therefore,
Be it resolved by the Senate:
