SECTION 1. Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the North Carolina General Statutes is	
amended b	by adding a new section to read:
"§ 58-3-305. Third-party premium payments; refusal of acceptance.	
<u>(a)</u>	A health benefit plan must accept a premium payment made by a third party to the
insurance	contract provided the payment is made from or pursuant to a fund or grant
established by any of the following:	
	(1) The Ryan White HIV/AIDS program pursuant to Title XXVI of the Public
	Health Service Act.
	(2) Native American tribes or tribal organizations.
	(3) State or federal government programs.
	(4) The American Kidney Foundation.
<u>(b)</u>	Nothing in this section shall be construed to require a health benefit plan to accept a
third-party premium payment for a health care provider,	
(c)	As used in this section, "health benefit plan" is as defined in G.S. 58-3-167(a)(1)."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2015, and applies to health

benefit contracts issued, renewed, or amended on or after that date.
