SECTION 1. Definition. – The term "autonomous vehicle technology" means		
technology that is installed on a motor vehicle and that has the capability to drive the motor		
vehicle without the active control or monitoring of a human operator.		
	CTION 2. Study. – The Division of Motor Vehicles, in collaboration with or	
interested stakeholders identified by the Division, shall study how to implement autonomous		
vehicle technology on the roads and highways of this State. In conducting the study under this		
act, the Division shall consider all of the following:

SECTION 3. Report. – The Department shall report its findings and
