14	<u>(2)</u>	Corrective affidavit. – An affidavit executed by an attorney to correct an
15		obvious description error, typographical error, or other minor error in a deed,
16	(2)	deed of trust, or other instrument recorded with the register of deeds.
17	<u>(3)</u>	Obvious description error. – An error in the legal description of real property
18		that is contained in a recorded deed, deed of trust, mortgage, or other
19		conveyance where the subject parcel is properly identified in the instrument
20	ar an	being corrected and is shown on a recorded subdivision plat."
21		TION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2015, and applies to corrective
22	affidavits filed on or after that date.
