BILL SUMMARY:

Prohibits the Secretary of Administration (Secretary) and other entities subject to Article 3 (purchases and contracts) from contracting with a vendor that employs or contracts with a person who is a former state employee and uses that person in the administration of a contract with the state. Requires the Secretary to require each vendor submitting a bid or contract to certify that they will not use a former state employee in administering a contract with the state. Violations of the statute void the contract. Defines administration of a contract and former state employee.

Applies to contracts entered into on or after October 1, 2015.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

The certification requirements contained in this bill should not create a new financial burden on any state agency.
