2	AN ACT TO DIRECT THE CITY OF WILMINGTON TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A

4	UNMET NEEDS OF OPIATE OVERDOSE VICTIMS WHO ARE IN NEED OF
5	FOLLOW-UP TREATMENT, COUNSELING, SUPPORT, AND OTHER RECOVERY
6	SERVICES.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. Pilot Project. – The Department of Public Safety, in conjunction with
9	the City of Wilmington, shall develop and implement a pilot project to establish a "Quick
10	Response Team" (QRT) to address the needs of opiate and heroin overdose victims who are not
11	getting follow-up treatment. The QRT shall be staffed by firefighters, police officers, medics, and
12	other law enforcement as determined by the Department of Public Safety and the City of
13	Wilmington. The Department of Public Safety and the City of Wilmington shall work together to
14	develop the policy and procedures for the QRT. In doing so, all of the following shall be
15	considered:
16	(1) Increase engagement and treatment with family counseling and recovery
17	groups.
18	(2) Provide follow-up care to survivable overdose incidents with police/medics and
19	licensed counselors.
20	(3) Provide short- and long-term support to overdose victims and families.
21	(4) Provide follow-up within three to five days after an initial incident.
22	(5) Create a fatal review panel to analyze and keep track of the deaths of those
23	served by QRT.
24	SECTION 2. Report. – The Department of Public Safety and the City of Wilmington
25	shall report on the results of the pilot project to the 2019 Regular Session of the General
26	Assembly, upon its reconvening.
27	SECTION 3. Appropriation. – There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
28	Department of Public Safety the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in recurring
29	funds for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 fiscal years to fund the implementation of a Quick
