17	SECTION 2. Development of Program. – The Department of Transportation shall		
18	develop a program whereby an individual may apply to the Department for the erection of a		
19	memorial on the roadside of a highway honoring an immediate family member of the		
20	individual who was a service member of any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States		
21	and was killed in the line of duty. The program shall include both of the following:

29		ECTION 3. Report. – By September 1, 2017, the Department of Trans	
30	shall provide an interim report to the Joint Legislative Transportation Oversight Committee on		
31	the progress made by the Department in developing the program required by Section 1 of this		
32	act. By January 1, 2018, the Department shall provide a final report to the Joint Legislative		
33	Transportation Oversight Committee on the specific details of the program developed in		
34	accordance with Section 1 of this act, including any recommendations as to implementation of		
35	the program.
