10 **SECTION 1.1.** The appropriations made in this act are for maximum amounts 11 necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the budget. Savings 12 shall be effected where the total amounts appropriated are not required to perform these 13 services and accomplish these purposes, and the savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at 14 the end of each fiscal year, except as otherwise provided by G.S. 143C-1-2(b).

17 SECTION 1.2. This act shall be known as the "Current Operations and Capital 18 Improvements Appropriations Act of 2017."
