March 14, 2017 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF INSTRUCTION AT THE CONSTITUENT 3 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 **SECTION 1.** Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a 6 new section to read: 7 "§ 116-11.5. Duties regarding faculty teaching standards. 8 The Board of Governors shall adopt a policy, in accordance with this section, applicable to all constituent institutions except the North Carolina School of Science and Math and 9 10 the University of North Carolina School of the Arts, that sets faculty teaching standards 11 differentiated by the type of institution, according to Carnegie Classification institution types, and 12 by course discipline, according to course discipline types defined by the American Academy of 13 Arts and Sciences. 14 (b) For the purposes of this section, the following definitions apply: Research Universities I: North Carolina State University and the University of 15 (1) North Carolina at Chapel Hill. 16 17 Doctoral Universities I: East Carolina University, North Carolina Agricultural **(2)** and Technical State University, the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, 18 19 and the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. 20 Masters Institutions I (Comprehensive): Appalachian State University, (3) 21 Fayetteville State University, North Carolina Central University, the University 22 of North Carolina at Pembroke, the University of North Carolina at 23 Wilmington, and Western Carolina University. Baccalaureate Institutions I, II: Elizabeth City State University, the University 24 (4) 25 of North Carolina at Asheville, and Winston-Salem State University. 26 STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics): Courses taught (5) in the disciplines of mathematics, physical sciences, and biological sciences, as 27 defined by the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, including courses in 28 29 engineering, computer science, and health care and allied professions. Humanities and Social Sciences: Courses taught in the disciplines of humanities 30 (6) and social sciences, as defined by the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, 31 32 including courses in business and education. 33 The average faculty teaching load for each department at a constituent institution shall 34 be as follows, according to the appropriate categories: 35

Research Universities I: <u>(1)</u>

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STEM: 4.0 courses per year. a.



It is not the intent of this section that the proceeds from any endowment fund shall take number of people. However, the proceeds of an endowment fund may be used to supplement the salary of a professor whose salary has been reduced pursuant to G.S. 116-11.5."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to academic years beginning on or after July 1, 2017.

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
