Whereas, each nomination is subject to senatorial advice and consent in conformance with Section 5(8) of Article III of the North Carolina Constitution; and	
Whereas, a vacancy existed in one such position prior to the convening of the 2017 General Assembly; and	
Whereas, under G.S. 143B-9(a), the Governor is authorized to make an appointment to such a vacancy pending further action by the Senate; and	
Whereas, the Governor has appointed Tony Copeland to serve as Secretary of the Department of Commerce pending further action by the Senate; Now, therefore,	
Be it resolved by the Senate:

SECTION 1. That the Senate shall hereby consider Copeland as Secretary of the Department of Commerce.
