A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES, FOR A GRANT-IN-AID TO GUILFORD COUNTY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FACILITY-BASED MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS CENTER FOR ADULTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The following amounts are appropriated to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services (DMH/DD/SAS), to be used to provide a grant-in-aid to Guilford County for the construction of a facility-based mental health crisis center to serve adults in Guilford County:

- (1) From the General Fund, the sum of three million eight hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$3,850,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2019-2020 fiscal year and the sum of three million eight hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$3,850,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.
- (2) From the Dorothea Dix Hospital Property Fund, the sum of two million three hundred thousand dollars (\$2,300,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2019-2020 fiscal year.

Guilford County shall not use these funds for any purpose other than the purpose stated in this section.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
