4	LICENSED TO PRACTICE MEDICINE IN THIS STATE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 90-270.90(4) reads as rewritten:
7	"(4) "Physical therapy" means the evaluation or treatment of any person by the use
8	of physical, chemical, or other properties of heat, light, water, electricity,
9	sound, massage, or therapeutic exercise, or other rehabilitative procedures,
10	with or without assistive devices, for the purposes of preventing, correcting,
11	or alleviating a physical or mental disability. Physical therapy includes the
12	performance of specialized tests of neuromuscular function, administration of
13	specialized therapeutic procedures, interpretation and implementation of
14	referrals from licensed medical doctors or dentists, and establishment and
15	modification of physical therapy programs for patients. Evaluation and
16	treatment of patients may involve physical measures, methods, or procedures
17	as are found commensurate with physical therapy education and training and
18	generally or specifically authorized by regulations of the Board. Physical
19	therapy education and training shall include study of the skeletal
20	manifestations of systemic disease. Physical therapy does not include the
21	application of roentgen rays or radioactive materials, surgery, manipulation of
22	the spine unless prescribed by a physician licensed to practice medicine in
23	North Carolina, or medical diagnosis of disease."
24	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2019.
