Short Title: Feasibility of Textile Historic Site. (Public)

Sponsors: Senator Tillman (Primary Sponsor).

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL AND CULTURAL  
3 RESOURCES TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A STATE  
4 HISTORIC SITE TO INTERPRET THE STATE'S TEXTILE PRODUCTION AND  
5 INDUSTRIAL HISTORY.  
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
7 **SECTION 1.** The Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, Office of Archives  
8 and History, shall evaluate the real property and textile collection held by the Randolph Heritage  
9 Conservancy, Inc., located in the Town of Franklinville, to determine the feasibility of its use in  
10 establishing a State historic site or State museum to interpret the State's textile production and  
11 industrial history. By May 1, 2020, the Commission shall report its findings and  
12 recommendations to the Randolph County Board of County Commissioners, the Randolph  
13 Heritage Conservancy, Inc., and the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Agriculture and  
14 Natural and Economic Resources.  
15 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
