A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EMPOWER WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITIES DURING PERIODS OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCIES TO MODIFY REVENUE COLLECTION PRACTICES AND TO FUND PROGRAMS OF PAYMENT ASSISTANCE FOR PERSONS OF LOW INCOME.

SECTION 1. G.S. 162A-6(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

8 "(9b) To suspend standard revenue collection practices during a declared emergency 9 in order to assure continuation of service during the emergency, and to apply 10 grants and other federal, State, and local funds to replace revenues lost as a result of customer delinquency during the emergency. During a suspension of 11 12 revenue collection practices under this subdivision, the authority may make accommodations, including the forgiveness of balances in arrears from 13 14 low-income customers, to the extent of and when required as a condition for receipt of the federal, State, or local funding. For purposes of this subdivision, 15 "declared emergency" means the period of an emergency, as defined in 16 G.S. 166A-19.3, declared by one of the authorities set out in G.S. 166A-19.20 17 18 or G.S. 155A-19.22 for an area that includes all or part of the service area of 19 the authority and "low-income" means persons in households the annual 20 income of which, adjusted for family size, is not more than sixty percent 21 (60%) of the local area median family income as defined by the most recent figures published by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban 22 Development." 23 24

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2021.
