RESOLUTION 94
HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1014

A HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CELEBRATION OF THE
FOURTH OF JULY IN EDEN.

Whereas, there has been extended to the members of the General Assembly by the City of Eden an invitation to attend their "Ole Fashion Fourth of July" celebration on July 3, 1971; and

Whereas, it is necessary that we, as a people, be proud of our heritage and appreciative of our country, and be ever mindful of those sacrifices of our forebears who fought for this country's independence; and

Whereas, a true Fourth of July spirit should be a matter of public interest and concern and should not be left only to perfunctory national declarations and observances, but should be celebrated by individuals, communities and organizations throughout our land;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

Section 1. That the members of the House of Representatives and the Senate commend the celebration of the Fourth of July in the City of Eden, and urge the attendance of the members at that celebration.

Sec. 2. That this resolution shall become effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified, this the 5th day of July, 1971.
