2	AN ACT TO REVISE THE EXEMPTION FOR SALES BY A NONPROFIT
3	ORGANIZATION WHEN THE NET PROCEEDS OF THE SALE BENEFIT THE
4	STATE OR ONE OF ITS INSTRUMENTALITIES OR AGENCIES.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 105-164.13(34) reads as rewritten:
7	"(34) Sales of items by a nonprofit civic, charitable, educational, scientific or
8	literary organization when the net proceeds of the sales will be given
9	or contributed to the State of North Carolina or to one or more of its
10	agencies or instrumentalities, or to one or more nonprofit charitable
11	organizations, one of whose purposes is to serve as a conduit through
12	which such net proceeds will flow to the State or to one or more of its
13	agencies or instrumentalities. This subdivision does not apply to sales
14	of prepared food and drink."
15	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective October 1, 2001, and applies to

sales made on or after that date.
