9	<b>SECTION 2.</b> A county may sell any improvements affixed to or lo	
10	real property that it has purchased through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program	
11	to Hurricane Floyd. These improvements may be sold and are exempt	
12	restrictions and limitations required to effectuate sales of real or personal	· · ·
13	provided for in Article 12 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes. No dwelling	g may be
14	sold pursuant to this section unless the following requirements are met:	
15	(1) The dwelling may be sold only to the verifiable owner of the	•
16	at the time of Hurricane Floyd, September 15, 1999, and must	t initially
