HOUSE BILL 196**

AN ACT TO EXEMPT FROM THE PUBLIC BIDDING LAWS THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST IN THE RESTORATION OF THE FAIR BARN AND COLLEGE OF THE ALBEMARLE IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MULTIPURPOSE FACILITY IN THE CITY OF ELIZABETH CITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** The provisions of Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes do not apply to the Fair Barn Restoration Project in the Village of Pinehurst.

**SECTION 1.(b)** This section applies only to the Village of Pinehurst.

**SECTION 2.(a)** The Board of Trustees of College of the Albemarle may contract for the construction of a multipurpose facility in the City of Elizabeth City without being subject to the provisions of Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes.

**SECTION 2.(b)** This section applies only to the Board of Trustees of College of the Albemarle in the City of Elizabeth City.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and expires January 1, 2006.
