A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE CORRECTIONS AND CRIME
CONTROL OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE ISSUE OF PERSONS
WHO ESCAPE FROM THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE
JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Joint Legislative Corrections and Crime Control 7 Oversight Committee shall study the issue of persons who escape from the custody of 8 the Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention ("Department") and 9 shall develop appropriate sanctions for those persons. In studying the issue, the 10 Committee shall consult with the Department, the Administrative Office of the Courts, 11 and the North Carolina Sentencing and Policy Advisory Commission to develop a 12 statutory scheme through which both juveniles and persons who are over the age of 16 13 14 years shall be punished for escaping from the custody of the Department.

The Joint Legislative Corrections and Crime Control Oversight Committee shall report its findings and legislative recommendations to the General Assembly on or before April 1, 2002.
