1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF 3 COMMUNITY-BASED PHARMACEUTICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS FOR 4 LOW-INCOME ELDERLY PERSONS IN NORTH CAROLINA. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 6 7 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year. These funds shall be used for a technical assistance 8

program to provide competitive grants to communities for technical assistance and start-up funding for pharmaceutical assistance programs. The technical assistance program shall enable local communities to affiliate with the State's negotiating system

12 for price rebates under the Medicaid program.
