3	STUDY COMMISSION CONTRACTS FOR ISSUANCE OF MOTOR VEHICLE
4	REGISTRATION PLATES AND CERTIFICATES TO INCREASE THE RATE

6	THE ISSUANCE OF PLATES AND CERTIFICATES.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-63(h) reads as rewritten:
9	"(h) Commission Contracts for Issuance of Plates and Certificates All
10	registration plates, registration certificates certificates, and certificates of title issued by
11	the Division, outside of those issued from the Raleigh offices of the said Division and
12	those issued and handled through the United States mail, shall be issued insofar as
13	practicable and possible through commission contracts entered into by the Division for
14	the issuance of such plates and certificates in localities throughout North Carolina with
15	persons, firms, corporations or governmental subdivisions of the State of North Carolina
16	and the Carolina. The Division shall make a reasonable effort in every locality, except
17	as hereinbefore noted, noted above, to enter into a commission contract for the issuance
18	of such plates and certificates and a record of these efforts shall be maintained in the
19	Division. In the event the Division is unsuccessful in making commission contracts as
20	hereinbefore set out contracts, it shall then issue said the plates and certificates through
21	the regular employees of the Division. Whenever registration plates, registration
22	certificates <u>certificates</u> , and certificates of title are issued by the Division through
23	commission contract arrangements, the Division shall provide proper supervision of
24	such the distribution. Commission contracts entered under this subsection shall provide
25	for the payment of compensation for all transactions as set forth below. Nothing
26	contained in this subsection will allow or permit the operation of fewer outlets in any
27	county in this State than are now being operated.
28	Commission contracts entered into by the Division under this subsection shall
29	provide for the payment of compensation on a per transaction basis. The collection of

11	(4)	Acceptance of a surrendered registration plate, registration card, or

13		person cannot surrender a registration plate, registration card, or	
14		registration renewal sticker.	
15	(5)	Cancellation of a title because the vehicle has been junked.	
16	(6)	Acceptance of an application for, or issuance of, a refund for a fee or a	
17		tax, other than the highway use tax.	
18	(7)	Receipt of the civil penalty imposed by G.S. 20-309 for a lapse in	
19		financial responsibility or receipt of the restoration fee imposed by that	
20		statute.	
21	(8)	Acceptance of a notice of failure to maintain financial responsibility	
22		for a motor vehicle.	
23	(8a)	Collection of civil penalties imposed for violations of G.S. 20-183.8A.	
24	(8b)	Sale of one or more inspection stickers in a single transaction to a	
25		licensed inspection station.	
26	(9)	Collection of the highway use tax.	
27	(10)	Acceptance of a temporary lien filing.	
28		e at the same time of any combination of the items that are listed within	
29	each subdivision or are listed within subdivisions (1) through (8b) of this section is a		
30	single transaction for which a dollar and thirty-five cent (\$1.35) compensation shall be		
31	paid. Performance of the item listed in subdivision (9) of this subsection in combination
