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3	(1)	The minimum fee for a vehicle licensed under this subsection is
4		seventeen dollars and fifty cents (\$17.50) one dollar (\$1.00) every five
5		<u>years</u> at the farmer rate and twenty-one dollars and fifty cents (\$21.50)
6		at the general rate.
7	(2)	The term "farmer" as used in this subsection means any person
8		engaged in the raising and growing of farm products on a farm in
9		North Carolina not less than 10 acres in area, and who does not engage
10		in the business of buying products for resale.
11	(3)	License plates issued at the farmer rate shall be placed upon trucks and
12		truck-tractors that are operated exclusively in the carrying or
13		transportation of applicant's farm products, raised or produced on his
14		farm, and farm supplies and not operated in hauling for hire.
15	(4)	"Farm products" means any food crop, livestock, poultry, dairy
16		products, flower bulbs, or other nursery products and other agricultural
17		products designed to be used for food purposes, including in the term
18		"farm products" also cotton, tobacco, logs, bark, pulpwood, tannic acid
19		wood and other forest products grown, produced, or processed by the
20		farmer.
21	(5)	The Division shall issue necessary rules and regulations providing for
22		the recall, transfer, exchange or cancellation of "farmer" plates, when
23		vehicle bearing such plates shall be sold or transferred.
24	(5a)	Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter, license plates
25		issued pursuant to this subsection at the farmer rate may be purchased
26		for any three-month period at one fourth of the annual fee.
27	(6)	There shall be paid to the Division annually as of the first of January,
28		the following fees for "wreckers" as defined under G.S. 20-4.01(50): a
29		wrecker fully equipped weighing 7,000 pounds or less, seventy-five
30		dollars (\$75.00); wreckers weighing in excess of 7,000 pounds shall
31		pay one hundred forty-eight dollars (\$148.00). Fees to be prorated
32		quarterly. Provided, further, that nothing herein shall prohibit a
33		licensed dealer from using a dealer's license plate to tow a vehicle for a
34		customer."
35	SECT	<b>FION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2003.
