2	AN ACT TO PROTECT SCHOOL GROUNDS FROM IMPAIRED DRIVERS.
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-138.1(a) reads as rewritten:
5	"(a) Offense. – A person commits the offense of impaired driving if he drives any
6	vehicle upon any highway, any street, any school grounds, or any public vehicular area
7	within this State:
8	(1) While under the influence of an impairing substance; or
9	(2) After having consumed sufficient alcohol that he has, at any relevant
10	time after the driving, an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more."
11	SECTION 2. G.S. 20-4.01 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
12	"(39a) School Grounds. – All of any tract, parcel, or lot, any part of which is
13	used by any public, private, or parochial school, college, university, or
14	other educational institution for educational purposes."
15	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to
16	offenses committed on or after that date.
