1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT PEDIATRIC CANCER
3	PROGRAMS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
6	Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Health, the sum of two hundred
7	fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of two
8	hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year to combat
9	pediatric cancer and its effects on the children of North Carolina. These funds shall be
10	allocated as follows:
11	(1) \$100,000 for clinical trials of experimental treatments that are not
12	funded by medical insurance;
13	(2) \$100,000 to expand and raise the awareness of pediatric cancer
14	including symptoms and treatment options; and
15	(3) \$50,000 to assist victims of pediatric cancer and their immediate
16	families with the expenses of attending retreats for families and
17	support and specialized camps.
18	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
