3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 105-164.4(a)(1f)b. is repealed.
5	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 105-164.4(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
6	read:
7	"(1g) The rate of two and seventy-three hundredths percent (2.73%) applies
8	to the sales price of electricity that is separately metered or separately
9	measured to manufacturing industries and manufacturing plants for use
10	in connection with the operation of the industries or plants other than
11	sales of electricity to be used for residential heating purposes. The
12	quantity of electricity purchased or used at any one time is not a
13	determinative factor as to whether its sale or use is or is not subject to
14	the rate of tax provided in this subdivision."
15	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2001, and applies to sales
16	made on or after that date.
