The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 18B-1000 reads as rewritten:

"§ **18B-1000. Definitions concerning establishments.**The following requirements and definitions shall apply to this Chapter:

Restaurant. – An establishment substantially engaged in the business of preparing and serving meals. To qualify as a restaurant, an establishment's gross receipts from food and nonalcoholic beverages shall be not less than forty percent (40%) thirty percent (30%) of the total gross receipts from food, nonalcoholic beverages, and alcoholic beverages. A restaurant shall also have a kitchen and an inside dining area with seating for at least 36 people."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
